### Notice of Privacy Practices (HIPAA) and Patient's Rights

This notice describes how medical information about you may be used and disclosed and how you can get access to this information. Please review it carefully.

**Our Legal Duty:** NRG is required by applicable federal and state law to maintain the privacy of your health information. We are also required to give you this Notice about our privacy practices, our legal duties and your rights concerning your health information. NRG must follow the privacy practices that are described in this Notice while it is in effect.

NRG reserves the right to change our privacy practices and the terms of this Notice at any time, provided such changes are permitted by applicable law. NRG reserves the right to make the changes in our privacy practices and the new terms of our Notice effective for all health information that we maintain, including health information we created or received before we made the changes.

NRG may use and disclose medical and financial information related to your care that may be necessary now or in the future to:

- Facilitate payment by third parties for goods and/or services rendered
- Assist with, aid in, or facilitate the collection of data for medical outcomes evaluation purposes
- Hospitals or physician offices that are providing similar care and may need the information to conduct the care at their site
- Government agencies and licensing organizations that have oversight duties regarding the delivery of goods and/or services
- Medical records that may be delivered to a primary physician or any other physician that is directly or indirectly responsible for your medical care or the payment thereof
- Provide the results of treatments which could be published in an article with patients receiving similar care but would not include any information that would identify you individually

NRG will not use or disclose any of your medical and/or financial information for any purpose not stated above without your specific authorization. You may revoke this authorization at any time.

As a patient you have the following rights:

1. The right to inspect and copy your information
2. The right to request corrections to your information
3. The right to request confidential communications
4. The right to a report of disclosures of your information
5. The right to a paper copy of this Notice

You may register a complaint with NRG if you suspect that your privacy rights have been violated. We will investigate the complaint and inform you of the findings. NRG will make no retaliation against you because you registered a complaint.
